Remember is a short, understated piece meant to capture the conversational tone of the text. The poem was written by teen-aged Victorian poet Christina Rossetti, who had fallen verwill. It gives the living permission to acknowledge loss, and permission to find happiness again.

Performance note: In performance, rhythmic liberties can be taken to convey a more convincing reflection of a personal conversation.
